CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress regarding the prerogatives of each State for health care reform.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of the Congress that, if
3 the Congress enacts legislation providing for a national
4 program for health care reform which would restrict the
5 freedom of any individual State in setting its own course
6 toward health care reform which is reflective of the unique
7 experience of such State, such legislation should provide
8 for the inclusion of such State only upon approval of the

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- 1 inclusion of such State by a majority of the voters in such
- 2 State in a State referendum conducted on the issue of the
- 3 inclusion of such State.

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
