Whereas decorative painters engage in numerous worthwhile
philanthropic activities in communities across the United
States: Now, therefore, be it

- 1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
- 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That October 1994 is designated as “National Decorative
- 4 Painting Month”, and the President of the United States

1 is authorized and requested to issue a proclamation calling
2 upon the people of the United States to observe such week
3 with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
