1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Main Post Office facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 1000 Lamar Street, Wichita
6 Falls, Texas, shall be known and designated as the “Gra-
7 ham B. Purcell, Jr., Post Office and Federal Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Graham B. Purcell, Jr., Post Office
6 and Federal Building”.
