3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 (a) GRANTS TO STATES.—Section 106(a) of the  
5 Technology-Related Assistance for Individuals with Dis-  
6 abilities Act of 1988 (29 U.S.C. 2216(a)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “1989 and” and inserting  
8 “1989,”; and

1           (2) by inserting before the period the following:  
2           “, and such sums as may be necessary for each suc-  
3           ceeding fiscal year ending before October 1, 1998”.

4           (b) PROGRAMS OF NATIONAL SIGNIFICANCE.—Sec-  
5           tion 241 of the Technology-Related Assistance for Individ-  
6           uals with Disabilities Act of 1988 (29 U.S.C. 2271) is  
7           amended—

8           (1) in subsection (a)—

9                   (A) by striking “1989 and” and inserting  
10                  “1989,”, and

11                   (B) by inserting before the period the fol-  
12                  lowing: “, and such sums as may be necessary  
13                  for each of the fiscal years 1994, 1995, 1996,  
14                  1997, and 1998”; and

15           (2) in subsection (b)—

16                   (A) by striking “1989 and” and inserting  
17                  “1989,”, and

18                   (B) by inserting before the period the fol-  
19                  lowing: “, and such sums as may be necessary  
20                  for each of the fiscal years 1994, 1995, 1996,  
21                  1997, and 1998”.
