To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a salmon captive broodstock program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Winter Run Chinook
5 Salmon Captive Broodstock Act of 1993.”

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF SALMON CAPTIVE**
7 **BROODSTOCK PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (d), the Sec-
9 retary of the Interior (hereinafter in this section referred
10 to as the “Secretary”) shall conduct in accordance with
11 this section a salmon captive broodstock program (herein-
12 after in this section referred to as the “Program”).

1 (b) PROGRAM.—The program shall be carried out in
2 a manner that is consistent with the goals, priorities, and
3 policies set forth in any recovery plan for winter run Chi-
4 nook salmon in the Sacramento River developed by the
5 National Marine Fisheries Service under the Endangered
6 Species Act of 1973, and with findings of consultations
7 regarding that population of salmon carried out pursuant
8 to section 7 of that Act.

9 (c) CONSULTATION.—The Secretary shall consult
10 with the Winter Run Chinook Salmon Captive Broodstock
11 Committee (a committee identified in the document enti-
12 tled “Biological Assessment on the Effects of Coleman
13 National Fish Hatchery Operations on Winter Run Chi-
14 nook Salmon”, prepared by the United States Fish and
15 Wildlife Service) in making management decisions regard-
16 ing the Program.

17 (d) STATE MATCHING.—The Secretary may not im-
18 plement this section unless not less than 20 percent of
19 amounts necessary to conduct the Program are provided
20 by non-Federal sources.

21 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
22 are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary to con-

1 duct the Program \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years
2 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, and 1998.
