1 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE STATE OF OKLA-**
2 **HOMA OWNED BY INDIAN HOUSING AUTHOR-**
3 **ITY FOR PURPOSE OF PROVIDING LOW-IN-**
4 **COME HOUSING TREATED AS FEDERAL PROP-**
5 **ERTY UNDER PUBLIC LAW 874, 81ST CON-**
6 **GRESS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any real property located in the
8 State of Oklahoma that—

9 (1) is owned by an Indian housing authority
10 and used for low-income housing (including housing
11 assisted under the mutual help homeownership op-
12 portunity program under section 202 of the United
13 States Housing Act of 1937), and

14 (2) at any time prior to the date of the enact-
15 ment of this Act—

16 (A) was designated by treaty as tribal
17 land, or

18 (B) satisfied the definition of Federal
19 property under section 403(1)(A) of the Act of
20 September 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, 81st
21 Congress),

22 shall be treated as Federal property under such section.

23 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply only
24 with respect to payments made under the Act of Septem-
25 ber 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, 81st Congress) for fiscal
26 year 1994.
