## A BILL

To revive and extend until January 1, 1996, the suspension  
of duty on Tfa Lys Pro in free base and tosyl salt forms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVIVAL AND EXTENSION OF DUTY SUSPEN-**

4 **SION.**

5 Heading 9902.30.53 of the Harmonized Tariff  
6 Schedule of the United States is amended by striking “12/  
7 31/92” and inserting “12/31/95”.

8 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by section  
10 1 applies with respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from

1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
2 the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION TO CERTAIN EN-  
4 TRIES.—Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tariff Act of  
5 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provision of law, upon  
6 a request filed with the appropriate customs officer before  
7 the date that is 90 days after the date of the enactment  
8 of this Act, any entry, or withdrawal from warehouse for  
9 consumption, of goods described in heading 9902.30.53 of  
10 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States that  
11 was made—

12 (1) after December 31, 1992, and

13 (2) before the 15th day after the date of the en-  
14 actment of this Act,

15 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such entry  
16 or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after the date of  
17 the enactment of this Act.
