A BILL

To terminate the gas turbine-modular helium reactor program of the Department of Energy, and to dedicate the savings to deficit reduction.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF GAS TURBINE-MODULAR HE-**
4 **LIUM REACTOR PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the provisions of
6 sections 2121 through 2126 of the Energy Policy Act of
7 1992 (106 Stat. 3081; 42 U.S.C. 13491 et seq.), the Sec-
8 retary of Energy shall take such actions as may be nec-
9 essary to terminate, as soon as possible, the gas turbine-

1 modular helium reactor program of the Department of
2 Energy.

3 (b) TRANSFER OF PROJECT FUNDS TO DEFICIT RE-
4 DUCATION FUND.—Of the funds made available under the
5 heading “Department of Energy—Energy Supply, Re-
6 search and Development Activities” in the Energy and
7 Water Development Appropriations Act, 1994 (Public
8 Law 103–126), \$12,000,000 shall be transferred to the
9 Deficit Reduction Fund established by Executive Order
10 12858 (58 Fed. Reg. 42185). Such sum shall be in addi-
11 tion to the amounts specified in section 2(b) of such order,
12 but shall be subject to the requirements and limitations
13 set forth in sections 2(c) and 3 of such order.

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
