A BILL

To modify the boundaries of Walnut Canyon National Monument in the State of Arizona.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Walnut Canyon Na-
3 tional Monument Boundary Modification Act of 1994”.

4 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.**

5 (a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds that:

6 (1) Walnut Canyon National Monument was es-
7 tablished for the preservation and interpretation of
8 certain settlements and land use patterns associated
9 with the prehistoric Sinaguan culture of northern
10 Arizona.

11 (2) Major cultural resources associated with the
12 purposes of Walnut Canyon National Monument are
13 near the boundary and are currently managed under
14 multiple-use objectives of the adjacent national for-
15 est. These concentrations of cultural resources, often
16 referred to as “forts”, would be more effectively
17 managed as part of the National Park System.

18 (b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this Act is to modify
19 the boundaries of the Walnut Canyon National Monument
20 (hereafter in this Act referred to as the “national monu-
21 ment”) to improve management of the national monument
22 and associated resources.

23 **SEC. 3. BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.**

24 Effective on the date of enactment of this Act, the
25 boundaries of the national monument shall be modified as
26 depicted on map entitled “Boundary Proposal—Walnut

1 Canyon National Monument, Coconino County, Arizona”
2 numbered 360/80,008, and dated June 1994 depicted on
3 the map entitled “Boundary Proposal—Walnut Canyon
4 National Monument, Coconino County, Arizona”, num-
5 bered 360/80,011, and dated September 1994. Such map
6 shall be on file and available for public inspection in the
7 offices of the Director of the National Park Service, De-
8 partment of the Interior.

9 **SEC. 4. ACQUISITION AND TRANSFER OF PROPERTY.**

10 The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to acquire
11 lands and interest in lands within the national monument,
12 by donation, purchase with donated or appropriated funds,
13 or exchange. Federal property within the boundaries of the
14 national monument (as modified by this Act) is hereby
15 transferred to the administrative jurisdiction of the Sec-
16 retary of the Interior for management as part of the na-
17 tional monument. Federal property excluded from the
18 monument pursuant to the boundary modification under
19 section 3 is hereby transferred to the administrative juris-
20 diction of the Secretary of Agriculture to be managed as
21 a part of the Coconino National Forest.

22 **SEC. 5. ADMINISTRATION.**

23 The Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-
24 rector of the National Park Service, shall manage the na-
25 tional monument in accordance with this Act and the pro-

1 visions of law generally applicable to units of the National
2 Park Service, including “An Act to establish a National
3 Park Service, *and for other purposes*” approved August 25,
4 1916 (39 Stat. 535; 16 U.S.C. 1, 2–4); ~~and for other pur-~~
5 ~~poses.~~

6 **SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 There is authorized to be appropriated such sums as
8 may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.
