A BILL

To amend the Revised Organic Act of the Virgin Islands to provide for the appointment of a United States marshal by the President.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) section 24(c) of the Revised Organic Act of the
4 Virgin Islands (48 U.S.C. 1614(c)) is amended by striking
5 “Attorney General” and inserting “President”.

6 (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall
7 apply to appointments of United States marshal for the

1 Virgin Islands made after the date of enactment of this
2 Act.
