## A BILL

To amend the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988 to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1995, 1996, and 1997 for drug abuse education and prevention for the benefit of youth.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DRUG EDUCATION AND PREVENTION RELAT-**  
4       **ING TO YOUTH GANGS.**

5       Section 3505 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988  
6       (42 U.S.C. 11805) is amended—

7               (1) by striking “\$16,000,000 for fiscal year  
8       1992 and”, and

1           (2) by striking “1993 and 1994” and inserting  
2           “1995, 1996, and 1997”.

3 **SEC. 2. PROGRAMS FOR RUNAWAY AND HOMELESS YOUTH.**

4           Section 3513 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988  
5 (42 U.S.C. 11823) is amended—

6           (1) by striking “\$16,000,000 for fiscal year  
7           1992 and”, and

8           (2) by striking “1993 and 1994” and inserting  
9           “1995, 1996, and 1997”.
