1 by inserting “out of any money in the Treasury not other-
2 wise appropriated,” before “for the benefit of counties”.

3 (b) BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT.—Section
4 13983(b)(1) of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of
5 1993 (Public Law 103–66; 107 Stat. 682; 43 U.S.C.
6 1181f note) is amended by inserting “, out of any money
7 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,” after “shall
8 make payments”.
