AN ACT

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act relating to San Diego ocean discharge and waste water reclamation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ocean Pollution Re-
5 duction Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SAN DIEGO OCEAN DISCHARGE AND WASTE WATER**
7 **RECLAMATION.**

8 Section 301(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control
9 Act (33 U.S.C. 1311(j)) is amended—

10 (1) in paragraph (1)(A) by inserting before the
11 semicolon at the end the following: “, and except as
12 provided in paragraph (5)”; and

13 (2) by adding at the end the following new
14 paragraph:

15 “(5) EXTENSION OF APPLICATION DEADLINE.—

16 “(A) IN GENERAL.—In the 180-day period
17 beginning on the date of the enactment of this
18 paragraph, the city of San Diego, California,

1 may apply for a modification pursuant to sub-
2 section (h) of the requirements of subsection
3 (b)(1)(B) with respect to biological oxygen de-
4 mand and total suspended solids in the effluent
5 discharged into marine waters.

6 “(B) APPLICATION.—An application under
7 this paragraph shall include a commitment by
8 the applicant to implement a waste water rec-
9 lamation program that, at a minimum, will—

10 “(i) achieve a system capacity of
11 45,000,000 gallons of reclaimed waste
12 water per day by January 1, 2010;

13 “(ii) result in a reduction in the quan-
14 tity of suspended solids discharged by the
15 applicant into the marine environment dur-
16 ing the period of the modification.

17 “(C) ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS.—The Ad-
18 ministrator may not grant a modification pur-
19 suant to an application submitted under this
20 paragraph unless the Administrator determines
21 that such modification will result in removal of
22 not less than 58 percent of the biological oxy-
23 gen demand (on an annual average) and not
24 less than 80 percent of total suspended solids

1 (on a monthly average) in the discharge to
2 which the application applies.

3 “(D) PRELIMINARY DECISION DEAD-
4 LINE.—The Administrator shall announce a
5 preliminary decision on an application submit-
6 ted under this paragraph not later than 1 year
7 after the date the application is submitted.”.
