## A BILL

To provide that annual pay adjustments for Members of Congress may not exceed cost-of-living increases in benefits under title II of the Social Security Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act  
4       of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31) is amended by adding at the end  
5       the following:

6       “(3)(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of this  
7       subsection, rates of pay for positions referred to in para-  
8       graph (1) may not be increased, under paragraph (2), in

1 excess of the maximum percentage increase allowable in  
2 any year.

3 “(B) For purposes of subparagraph (A), the maxi-  
4 mum percentage increase allowable under paragraph (2)  
5 in any year is the percentage equal to the percentage by  
6 which benefits under title II of the Social Security Act  
7 were increased during the 1-year period preceding the  
8 start of the calendar year involved, either under section  
9 215(i) of such Act or pursuant to a law providing a gen-  
10 eral benefit increase under such title.”.
