A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for burial in national cemeteries to persons who have 20 years of service creditable for retired pay as members of a reserve component of the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR BURIAL IN NATIONAL CEME-**
4 **TERIES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2402 of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-
8 graph (7); and

9 (2) by adding after paragraph (5) the following
10 new paragraph:

11 “(6) Any person who at the time of death was entitled
12 to retired pay under chapter 67 of title 10 or would have
13 been entitled to retired pay under that chapter but for
14 the fact that the person was under 60 years of age.”.

15 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—(1) Section
16 2301(e) of such title is amended by striking out “section
17 2402(6)” and inserting in lieu thereof “section 2402(7)”.

18 (2) Section 2306(a)(2) of such title is amended by
19 striking out “(6)” and inserting in lieu thereof “(7)”.
