## A BILL

To amend section 223 of the Communications Act of 1934 to prevent the harassment by computer modem or other electronic device.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Electronic Anti-Stalk-  
5 ing Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

7 Section 223(a) of the Communications Act of 1934  
8 (47 U.S.C. 223(a)) is amended by adding at the end there-  
9 of the following new sentence: “For purposes of subpara-  
10 graphs (B), (C), and (D), the terms ‘telephone’ and ‘tele-

1 phone call' include communications by means of computer  
2 modem or any other two-way wire or radio telecommuni-  
3 cations device.'".
