A BILL

To reinstate the permit for, and extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of, a hydroelectric project in Oregon, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF PERMIT EXTENSION**
4 **DEADLINE.**

5 Notwithstanding the expiration of the permit and
6 notwithstanding the time period specified in section 13 of
7 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would other-
8 wise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

1 project numbered 7829, the Commission shall, at the re-
2 quest of the licensee for the project, reinstate the permit
3 effective May 23, 1993, and extend the time period during
4 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-
5 tion of the project to the date that is 4 years after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act.
