A BILL

To reinstate the permit for, and extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of, a hydroelectric project in Oregon, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF PERMIT EXTENSION**
2 **DEADLINE.**

3 Notwithstanding the expiration of the permit and
4 notwithstanding the time period specified in section 13 of
5 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would other-
6 wise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
7 project numbered 7829, the Commission shall, at the re-
8 quest of the licensee for the project, reinstate the permit
9 effective May 23, 1993, and extend the time period during
10 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-
11 tion of the project to the date that is 4 years after the
12 date of the enactment of this Act.

13 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF PERMIT EXTENSION**
14 **DEADLINE.**

15 *Notwithstanding the expiration of the permit and not-*
16 *withstanding the time period specified in section 13 of the*
17 *Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise*
18 *apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission*
19 *project numbered 7829, the Commission shall, at the request*
20 *of the licensee for the project, reinstate the permit effective*
21 *May 23, 1993, and extend the time period during which*
22 *the licensee is required to commence the construction of the*
23 *project so as to terminate on May 25, 1999.*

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
