To require the Secretary of State to publish the names of United States citizens who renounce their citizenship.

Mr. GIBBONS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

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## A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to publish the names of United States citizens who renounce their citizenship.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PUBLICATION OF NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO**

4 **RENOUNCE UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
6 sion of law, not later than 30 days after the close of each  
7 calendar quarter ending after the date of the enactment  
8 of this Act, the Secretary of State shall publish in the Fed-  
9 eral Register the names of each United States citizen who

1 renounced such citizenship, or otherwise ceased to be such  
2 a citizen, during such quarter.

3 (b) RENUNCIATIONS ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1,  
4 1995, INCLUDED IN FIRST PUBLICATION.—The publica-  
5 tion under subsection (a) for the first calendar quarter  
6 ending after the date of the enactment of this Act shall  
7 include the names of each United States citizen who re-  
8 nounced such citizenship, or otherwise ceased to be such  
9 a citizen, on or after January 1, 1995, and before such  
10 calendar quarter.

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
