A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States Post Office building located at 24
5 Corliss Street, Providence, Rhode Island, shall be known
6 and designated as the “Harry Kizirian Post Office Build-
7 ing”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States Post Office building referred to in section 1 shall
5 be deemed to be a reference to the “Harry Kizirian Post
6 Office Building”.

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
