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## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to make certain technical corrections relating to physicians' services.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

### 3   SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4       This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Certification  
5   Act of 1995".

### 6   SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS RELATING TO PHYSI- 7                                   CIANS' SERVICES.

8       (a) IN GENERAL.—

1           (1) UNIQUE IDENTIFIERS.—Paragraph (59) of  
2       section 1902(a) of the Social Security Act (42  
3       U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended by striking “subsection  
4       (v)” and inserting “subsection (x)”.

5           (2) EXPENDITURES FOR PHYSICIANS’ SERV-  
6       ICES.—Section 1903(i)(12) of the Social Security  
7       Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b(i)(12)) is amended—

8           (A) by amending clause (i) of subpara-  
9       graph (A) to read as follows:

10           “(i) is certified in family practice or  
11           pediatrics by the medical specialty board  
12           recognized by the American Board of Med-  
13           ical Specialties for family practice or pedi-  
14           atrics or is certified in family practice or  
15           pediatrics by the medical specialty board  
16           recognized by the American Osteopathic  
17           Association,”;

18           (B) by amending clause (i) of subpara-  
19       graph (B) to read as follows:

20           “(i) is certified in family practice or  
21           obstetrics by the medical specialty board  
22           recognized by the American Board of Med-  
23           ical Specialties for family practice or ob-  
24           stetrics or is certified in family practice or  
25           obstetrics by the medical specialty board

1 recognized by the American Osteopathic  
2 Association,”; and

3 (C) in subparagraphs (A) and (B)—

4 (i) by striking “or” at the end of  
5 clause (v);

6 (ii) by redesignating clause (vi) as  
7 clause (vii); and

8 (iii) by inserting after clause (v) the  
9 following new clause:

10 “(vi) delivers such services in the  
11 emergency department of a hospital par-  
12 ticipating in the State plan approved under  
13 this title, or”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
15 subsection (a) shall be effective as if included in the enact-  
16 ment of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990.

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
