A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire property in the town of East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York, for inclusion in the Amagansett National Wildlife Refuge.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY FOR IN-**
4 **CLUSION IN THE AMAGANSETT NATIONAL**
5 **WILDLIFE REFUGE.**

6 (a) **AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY.**—The Sec-
7 retary of the Interior may acquire, for inclusion in the
8 Amagansett National Wildlife Refuge, the area known as

1 the Shadmoor Parcel, consisting of approximately 98 acres
2 (as determined by the Secretary) located along the Atlan-
3 tic Ocean adjacent to municipal park land in the town of
4 East Hampton, Suffolk County, New York.

5 (b) MANAGEMENT OF ACQUIRED INTERESTS.—
6 Lands and interests acquired by the United States under
7 this section shall be managed by the Secretary of the Inte-
8 rior as part of the Amagansett National Wildlife Refuge.

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
