A BILL

To modify the boundaries of the Talladega National Forest,
Alabama.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF TALLADEGA NATIONAL FOREST.**

4 (a) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—The exterior bound-
5 aries of the Talladega National Forest is hereby modified
6 to include the following described lands:

7 Huntsville Meridian, Township 17 South,
8 Range 8 East, Section 34, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and
9 S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Cleburne County, containing 339.40
10 acres, more or less.

1 Huntsville Meridian, Township 13 South,
2 Range 9 East, Section 28, SE¹/₄, Calhoun County,
3 containing 160.00 acres, more or less.

4 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—(1) Subject to valid existing
5 rights, all Federal lands described under subsection (a)
6 are hereby added to and shall be administered as part of
7 the Talladega National Forest.

8 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to af-
9 fect the validity of or the terms and conditions of any ex-
10 isting right-of-way, easement, lease, license, or permit on
11 lands transferred by subsection (a), except that such lands
12 shall be administered by the Forest Service. Reissuance
13 of any authorization shall be in accordance with the laws
14 and regulations generally applying to the Forest Service,
15 and the change of jurisdiction over such lands resulting
16 from the enactment of this Act shall not constitute a
17 ground for the denial of renewal or reissuance of such au-
18 thorization.

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
