Mr. COLEMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the reversionary interest of the United States in certain lands to the Clint Independent School District and the Fabens Independent School District.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY.**

4 Subject to section 2, the Secretary of State shall exe-
5 cute and file in the appropriate office such instrument as
6 may be necessary to release the reversionary interest of
7 the United States in the forty-acre tract of land referred
8 to in Public Law 85-42.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

2 The release under section 1 shall be made upon con-
3 dition that the Clint Independent School District and the
4 Fabens Independent School District in the State of Texas
5 use any proceeds received from the disposal of such land
6 for public educational purposes.
