A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States Post Office building located at 102
5 South McLean, Lincoln, Illinois, shall be known and des-
6 ignated as the “Edward Madigan Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States Post Office building referred to in section 1 shall
5 be deemed to be a reference to the “Edward Madigan Post
6 Office Building”.
