1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE AND EXTENSION**

2 **DEADLINE.**

3 Notwithstanding the expiration of the license and
4 notwithstanding the time period specified in section 13 of
5 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would other-
6 wise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
7 project numbered 3218, the Commission shall, at the re-
8 quest of the licensee for the project, reinstate the license
9 effective September 25, 1993, and extend the time period
10 during which the licensee is required to commence the con-
11 struction of the project so as to terminate on September
12 24, 1999.

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
