5 **TAIN COUNTY-OPERATED HEALTH INSURING**
6 **ORGANIZATIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9517(c)(3)(B)(ii) of the
8 Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985
9 (42 U.S.C. 1396b note), as added by section 4734 of the
10 Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, is amended
11 by inserting “or counties” after “county”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13 subsection (a) shall apply to quarters beginning on or
14 after October 1, 1996.

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
