3 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING COUNTY-OPERATED HEALTH IN-**
4 **SURING ORGANIZATIONS TO ENROLL MEDIC-**
5 **AID BENEFICIARIES RESIDING IN ANOTHER**
6 **COUNTY UNDER MEDICAID WAIVER FOR CER-**
7 **TAIN COUNTY-OPERATED HEALTH INSURING**
8 **ORGANIZATIONS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9517(c)(3)(B)(ii) of the
10 Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985
11 (42 U.S.C. 1396b note), as added by section 4734 of the
12 Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, is amended
13 by inserting “or counties” after “county”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
15 subsection (a) shall apply to quarters beginning on or
16 after October 1, 1996.

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
