Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey the Walhalla
National Fish Hatchery to the State of South Carolina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Walhalla National Fish
5 Hatchery Conveyance Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF WALHALLA NATIONAL FISH**
7 **HATCHERY TO THE STATE OF SOUTH CARO-**
8 **LINA.**

9 (a) **CONVEYANCE REQUIREMENT.**—Within 180 days
10 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary

1 of the Interior shall convey to the State of South Carolina
2 without reimbursement all right, title, and interest of the
3 United States in and to the property described in sub-
4 section (b), for use by the South Carolina Department of
5 Natural Resources as part of the State of South Carolina
6 fish culture program.

7 (b) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—The property referred
8 to in subsection (a) is the property known as the Walhalla
9 National Fish Hatchery, located on Indian Camp Creek
10 and the East Fork of Chattooga River off of State Second-
11 ary Highway 325 in northern Oconee County, South Caro-
12 lina, consisting of 76.2 acres (more or less), all improve-
13 ments and related personal property under the control of
14 the Secretary that is located on that property, including
15 buildings, structures, and equipment, and all easements,
16 leases, and water rights relating to that property.

17 (c) USE AND REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—The prop-
18 erty conveyed to the State of South Carolina pursuant to
19 this section shall be used by the State for purposes of fish-
20 ery resources management, and if it is used for any other
21 purpose all right, title, and interest in and to all property
22 conveyed pursuant to this section shall revert to the
23 United States.

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
