A BILL

To amend the Federal Trade Commission Act to authorize
appropriations for the Federal Trade Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Trade Com-
5 mission Reauthorization Act of 1996”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION.**

7 Section 25 of the Federal Trade Commission Act (15
8 U.S.C. 57c) is amended by striking “and not to exceed”
9 and inserting “not to exceed” and by inserting before the
10 period the following: “; not to exceed \$107,000,000 for

- 1 fiscal year 1997; and not to exceed \$111,000,000 for fiscal
- 2 year 1998”.
