To approve a governing international fishery agreement between the United States and the People's Republic of China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AGREEMENT WITH PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF**
4 **CHINA.**

5 Notwithstanding section 203 of the Magnuson Fish-
6 ery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. 1823),
7 the governing international fishery agreement between the
8 Government of the United States of America and the Gov-
9 ernment of the People's Republic of China, as contained
10 in the message to Congress from the President of the

1 United States dated September 20, 1994, is approved as
2 a governing international fishery agreement for the pur-
3 poses of such Act and shall enter into force and effect
4 with respect to the United States on the date of enactment
5 of this Act.
