A BILL

To extend the time for construction of certain FERC licensed
hydro projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION.**

4 Notwithstanding the limitations of section 13 of the
5 Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
6 mission, upon the request of the licensee or licensees for

1 FERC projects numbered 4244 and 10648 (and after rea-
2 sonable notice), is authorized in accordance with the good
3 faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of
4 such section 13 and the Commission's procedures under
5 such section, to extend the time required for commence-
6 ment of construction for each of such projects for up to
7 a maximum of 3 consecutive 2-year periods. This section
8 shall take effect for the projects upon the expiration of
9 the extension (issued by the Commission under such sec-
10 tion 13) of the period required for commencement of con-
11 struction of each such project.

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
