A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL.**

4 The first sentence of section 1447(c) of title 28,
5 United States Code, is amended by striking “any defect
6 in removal procedure” and inserting “any defect other
7 than lack of subject matter jurisdiction”.

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
