Mr. BRADLEY (for himself and Mr. LAUTENBERG) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize extension of time limitation for a FERC-issued hydroelectric license.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding the time limitation of section 13 of
4 the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory
5 Commission, upon the request of the licensee for FERC
6 Project No. 9401 is authorized, in accordance with the
7 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements
8 of section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such
9 section, to extend until August 3, 1999, the time required
10 for the licensee to commence the construction of such

1 project. This section shall take effect for the project upon
2 the expiration of the extension (issued by the Commission
3 under section 13) of the period required for commence-
4 ment of construction of such project.
