Mr. YATES (for himself and Mr. GILMAN) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Oversight

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony as part of the commemoration of the days of remembrance of victims of the Holocaust.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized
3 to be used from 8 o'clock ante meridian until 3 o'clock
4 post meridian on April 23, 1998, for a ceremony as part
5 of the commemoration of the days of remembrance of vic-
6 tims of the Holocaust. Physical preparations for the cere-
7 mony shall be carried out in accordance with such condi-
8 tions as the Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
