Mr. SMITH of Oregon introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Resources

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain
land to the City of Grants Pass, Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF BLM LAND TO GRANTS PASS,**

4 **OREGON.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the
6 Interior shall promptly convey to the City of Grants Pass,
7 Oregon (in this section referred to as the “City”), without
8 monetary compensation, all right, title, and interest of the
9 United States in and to the real property described in sub-
10 section (b).

1 (b) PROPERTY DESCRIBED.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The real property referred
3 to in subsection (a) is that parcel of land depicted
4 on the map entitled “_____” and dated
5 _____, 1997, consisting of—

6 (A) approximately 200 acres of Bureau of
7 Land Management land on which the City has
8 operated a landfill under lease; and

9 (B) approximately 120 acres of Bureau of
10 Land Management land that are adjacent to
11 the land described in subparagraph (A).

12 (2) DETERMINATION BY SECRETARY.—The
13 Secretary of the Interior may determine more par-
14 ticularly the real property described in paragraph
15 (1).

16 (c) CONSIDERATION.—As consideration for the con-
17 veyance under subsection (a), the Secretary shall require
18 the City to agree to indemnify the Government of the
19 United States for all liability of the Government that
20 arises from the property.

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
