Mr. GRAMS (for himself, Mr. D'AMATO, Mr. SARBANES, Ms. MOSELEY-BRAUN, Mr. MCCONNELL, and Mr. LEAHY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs

A BILL

To reauthorize the Export-Import Bank of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.**

4 Section 7 of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
5 (12 U.S.C. 635f) is amended by striking “1997” and in-
6 serting “2001”.

7 **SEC. 2. TIED AID CREDIT FUND AUTHORITY.**

8 (a) Section 10(c)(2) of the Export-Import Bank Act
9 of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635i-3(e)(2)) is amended by striking
10 “through September 30, 1997”.

1 (b) Section 10(e) of such Act (12 U.S.C. 635i–3(e))
2 is amended by striking the first sentence and inserting the
3 following: “There are authorized to be appropriated to the
4 Fund such sums as may be necessary to carry out the
5 purposes of this section.”.

6 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FINANC-**
7 **ING FOR THE EXPORT OF NONLETHAL DE-**
8 **FENSE ARTICLES OR SERVICES THE PRIMARY**
9 **END USE OF WHICH WILL BE FOR CIVILIAN**
10 **PURPOSES.**

11 Section 1(c) of Public Law 103–428 (12 U.S.C. 635
12 note; 108 Stat. 4376) is amended by striking “1997” and
13 inserting “2001”.
