**AN ACT**

To establish designations for United States Postal Service buildings in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ROXANNE H. JONES POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States Postal Serv-  
5 ice building located at 2601 North 16th Street, in Phila-  
6 delphia, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as  
7 the “Roxanne H. Jones Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall

1 be deemed to be a reference to the “Roxanne H. Jones  
2 Post Office Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. FREEMAN HANKINS POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States Postal Serv-  
5 ice building located at 5300 West Jefferson Street, in  
6 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated  
7 as the “Freeman Hankins Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
10 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall  
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “Freeman Hankins  
12 Post Office Building”.

13 **SEC. 3. MAX WEINER POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

14 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States Postal Serv-  
15 ice building located at 2037 Chestnut Street, in Philadel-  
16 phia, Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the  
17 “Max Weiner Post Office Building”.

18 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
19 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
20 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall  
21 be deemed to be a reference to the “Max Weiner Post  
22 Office Building”.
