A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The bridge on United States Route 231 that crosses
5 the Ohio River between Maceo, Kentucky, and Rockport,
6 Indiana, shall be known and designated as the “William
7 H. Natcher Bridge”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the bridge
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “William H. Natcher Bridge”.

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
