AN ACT

To dedicate the Big South Trail in the Comanche Peak
Wilderness Area of Roosevelt National Forest in Colo-
rado to the legacy of Jaryd Atadero.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. FINDING.**

2 Congress finds that Jaryd Atadero, a 3-year old boy
3 from Littleton, Colorado, was last seen the morning of Oc-
4 tober 2, 1999, 1½ miles from the trailhead of the Big
5 South Trail in the Comanche Peak Wilderness Area of
6 Roosevelt National Forest.

7 **SEC. 2. DEDICATION.**

8 Congress dedicates the Big South Trail in the Co-
9 manche Peak Wilderness Area of Roosevelt National For-
10 est to Jaryd Atadero and his legacy of promoting safe out-
11 door recreation for children.

12 **SEC. 3. SIGN.**

13 The Secretary of Agriculture shall recognize the loss
14 of Jaryd Atadero and the need for increased awareness
15 of child safety in outdoor recreation settings by posting
16 an interpretive sign at the Big South Trail trailhead
17 that—

18 (1) describes consideration for safe outdoor
19 recreation with children;

20 (2) refers to the tragic loss of Jaryd Atadero to
21 underscore the need for such safety considerations;

22 (3) refers to the dedication by Congress of this
23 trail and safety message to the legacy of Jaryd
24 Atadero; and

1 (4) for not less than 1 year, includes a copy of
2 this Act and an image of Jaryd Atadero.
