A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to authorize appropriations for the National Historical Publications and Records Commission for fiscal years 2002 through 2005.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR**
2 **THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PUBLICATIONS**
3 **AND RECORDS COMMISSION.**

4 Section 2504(f)(1) of title 44, United States Code,
5 is amended—

6 (1) in subparagraph (J), by striking “and”;

7 (2) in subparagraph (K), by striking the period
8 and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10 paragraphs:

11 “(L) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2002;

12 “(M) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2003;

13 “(N) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2004;

14 and

15 “(O) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2005.

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
