A BILL

To clarify certain boundaries on the map relating to Unit
NC01 of the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-**
4 **SOURCES SYSTEM MAP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The map described in subsection
6 (b) is replaced, in the maps depicting the Coastal Barrier
7 Resources System that are referred to in section 4(a) of
8 the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)),
9 by the map entitled “Pine Island Unit NC01” and dated
10 May 1, 2000.

1 (b) DESCRIPTION OF REPLACED MAP.—The map de-
2 scribed in this subsection is the map that—

3 (1) relates to Pine Island Unit NC01 located in
4 Currituck and Dare Counties, North Carolina; and

5 (2) is included in a set of maps entitled “Coast-
6 al Barrier Resources System”, dated October 24,
7 1990, revised on October 23, 1992, and referred to
8 in section 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
9 (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)).

10 (c) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
11 shall keep the replacement map referred to in subsection
12 (a) on file and available for inspection in accordance with
13 section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
14 U.S.C. 3503(b)).

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
