3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 3500 Dolfield Avenue in Baltimore, Maryland,
6 shall be known and designated as the “Judge Robert Ber-
7 nard Watts, Sr. Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Judge Robert Bernard Watts, Sr. Post Office
6 Building”.

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
