AN ACT

To amend the Small Business Act to change the conditions of participation and provide an authorization of appropriations for the women's business center program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Business
3 Center Amendments Act of 1999”.

4 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 29(c)(1) of the Small
6 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 656(c)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (A) by inserting “and”
8 after the semicolon at the end; and

9 (2) by striking subparagraphs (B) and (C) and
10 inserting the following:

11 “(B) in the third, fourth, and fifth years,
12 1 non-Federal dollar for each Federal dollar.”.

13 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this
14 section shall apply beginning October 1, 1998.

15 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

16 Section 29(k)(1) of the Small Business Act (15
17 U.S.C. 656(k)(1)) is amended by striking “8,000,000”
18 and inserting “11,000,000”.
