Mr. BARRETT of Nebraska (for himself, Mr. MARTINEZ, Mr. McKEON, Mr. GOODLING, and Mr. CLAY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To amend the Older Americans Act of 1965 to authorize
appropriations for fiscal years 2000 through 2003.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Older Americans Act
5 Amendments of 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 (a) FEDERAL COUNCIL ON THE AGING.—Section
8 204(g) of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.
9 3015(g)) is amended by striking “\$300,000 for fiscal year
10 1992 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal years

1 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as may
 2 be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”.

3 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—Section 215 of the Older
 4 Americans Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3020f) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “1992, 1993,
 6 1994, and 1995” and inserting “2000 through
 7 2003”, and

8 (2) in subsection (b) by amending paragraph
 9 (1) to read as follows:

10 “(1) such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
 11 years 2000 through 2003; and”.

12 (c) GRANTS FOR STATE AND COMMUNITY PROGRAMS
 13 ON AGING.—Section 303 of the Older Americans Act of
 14 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3023) is amended—

15 (1) in subsection (a)(1) by striking
 16 “\$461,376,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums
 17 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
 18 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
 19 essary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”,

20 (2) in subsection (b)—

21 (A) in paragraph (1) by striking
 22 “\$505,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
 23 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
 24 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as

1 may be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through
2 2003”,

3 (B) in paragraph (2) by striking
4 “\$120,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
5 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
6 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as
7 may be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through
8 2003”, and

9 (C) in paragraph (3) by striking
10 “\$15,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
11 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
12 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as
13 may be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through
14 2003”,

15 (3) in subsection (d) by striking “\$45,388,000
16 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
17 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
18 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
19 years 2000 through 2003”,

20 (4) in subsection (e) by striking “the fiscal
21 years 1992, 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting
22 “fiscal years 2000 through 2003”,

23 (5) in subsection (f) by striking “\$25,000,000
24 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
25 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and

1 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
2 years 2000 through 2003”, and

3 (6) in subsection (g) by striking “\$15,000,000
4 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
5 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
6 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
7 years 2000 through 2003”.

8 (d) AVAILABILITY OF SURPLUS COMMODITIES.—Sec-
9 tion 311(c)(1)(A) of the Older Americans Act of 1995 (42
10 U.S.C. 3030a(c)(1)(A)) is amended by striking
11 “\$250,000,000 for fiscal year 1992, \$310,000,000 for fis-
12 cal year 1993, \$380,000,000 for fiscal year 1994, and
13 \$460,000,000 for fiscal year 1995” and inserting “such
14 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through
15 2003”.

16 (e) TRAINING, RESEARCH, AND DISCRETIONARY
17 PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS.—Section 431 of the Older
18 Americans Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3037) is amended—

19 (1) in subsection (a)(1) by striking
20 “\$72,000,000 for fiscal year 1992, and such sums
21 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
22 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
23 essary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”, and

24 (2) in subsection (b) by striking “\$450,000 for
25 each of the fiscal years 1992, 1993, 1994, and

1 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
2 essary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”.

3 (f) COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT FOR OLDER
4 AMERICANS.—Section 508(a)(1) of the Older Americans
5 Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3056f(a)(1)) is amended by strik-
6 ing “\$470,671,000 for fiscal year 1992, and such sums
7 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
8 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be necessary for
9 fiscal years 2000 through 2003”.

10 (g) GRANTS FOR NATIVE AMERICANS.—Section
11 633(a) of the Older Americans Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C.
12 3057n(a)) is amended by striking “\$30,000,000 for fiscal
13 year 1992 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
14 years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums
15 as may be necessary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”.

16 (h) ALLOTMENTS FOR VULNERABLE ELDER RIGHTS
17 PROTECTION ACTIVITIES.—Section 702 of the Older
18 Americans Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3058a) is amended—

19 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “\$40,000,000
20 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
21 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
22 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
23 years 2000 through 2003”,

24 (2) in subsection (b) by striking “\$15,000,000
25 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-

1 necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
2 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
3 years 2000 through 2003”,

4 (3) in subsection (c) by striking “\$10,000,000
5 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
6 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
7 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
8 years 2000 through 2003”, and

9 (4) in subsection (d) by striking “\$15,000,000
10 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
11 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
12 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
13 years 2000 through 2003”.

14 (i) NATIVE AMERICAN PROGRAM.—Section 751(d) of
15 the Older Americans Act of 1995 (42 U.S.C. 3058aa(d))
16 is amended by striking “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year 1992,
17 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
18 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
19 essary for fiscal years 2000 through 2003”.

20 **SEC. 3. TRANSFERS.**

21 Section 308(b) of the Older Americans Act of 1965
22 (42 U.S.C. 3028(b)) is amended—

23 (1) in paragraph (4)(B)—

1 (A) by striking “fiscal year 1993, 1994,
2 1995, or 1996” and inserting “a fiscal year”,
3 and

4 (B) by striking “need—” and all that fol-
5 lows and inserting “need, an additional 10 per-
6 cent of the funds so received for the fiscal
7 year.”, and

8 (2) in paragraph (5)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (A) by striking “not
10 more than 30 percent for fiscal year 1993, not
11 more than 25 percent for fiscal year 1994, not
12 more than 25 percent for fiscal year 1995, and
13 not more than 20 percent for fiscal year 1996”
14 and inserting “not more than 20 percent for
15 the fiscal year involved”, and

16 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

17 (i) by striking “(B)(i)” and all that
18 follows through “(ii) If” and inserting
19 “(B) If”, and

20 (ii) by striking “for fiscal year 1996”
21 and inserting “for a fiscal year”.

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
