Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4690) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4690) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Ju-
2 diciary, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 2001, and for other purposes. The first
4 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
5 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
6 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
7 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
9 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
11 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
12 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: page
13 102, lines 15 through 17. During consideration of the bill
14 for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the
15 Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of
16 whether the Member offering an amendment has caused
17 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record
18 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.
19 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. The
20 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-
21 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-
22 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any
23 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum
24 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that
25 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-

1 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting
2 on the first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes.
3 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
4 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
5 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
6 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
7 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
8 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
9 or without instructions.
