Mr. SANTORUM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To expand the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military Park to include the Wills House, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK**
4 **BOUNDARY REVISION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1 of the Act entitled “An
6 Act to revise the boundary of the Gettysburg National
7 Military Park in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and
8 for other purposes” approved August 17, 1990 (16 U.S.C.
9 430g–4) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
2 section (c);

3 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(b) **ADDITIONAL LAND.**—In addition to the land
6 identified in subsection (a), the park shall also include the
7 property commonly known as the Wills House located in
8 the Borough of Gettysburg and identified as Tract P02–
9 1 on the map entitled ‘Gettysburg National Military Park’
10 numbered MARO 305/80,011 Segment 2, and dated April
11 1981, revised May 14, 1999.”; and

12 (3) in subsection (c) (as redesignated by para-
13 graph (1)), by striking “map referred to in sub-
14 section (a)” and inserting “maps referred to in sub-
15 sections (a) and (b)”.

16 **SEC. 2. ACQUISITION AND DISPOSAL OF LAND.**

17 Section 2 of the Act entitled “An Act to revise the
18 boundary of the Gettysburg National Military Park in the
19 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and for other purposes”
20 approved August 17, 1990 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4) is amend-
21 ed by striking “1(b)” each place it appears and inserting
22 “1(c)”.

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
