AN ACT

To amend the Act which established the Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site, in the State of New Hampshire, by modifying the boundary and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 That Public Law 88–543 (16 U.S.C. 461 (note)), which
2 established Saint-Gaudens National Historic Site is
3 amended—

4 (1) in section 3 by striking “not to exceed sixty-
5 four acres of lands and interests therein” and insert-
6 ing “279 acres of lands and buildings, or interests
7 therein”;

8 (2) in section 6 by striking “\$2,677,000” from
9 the first sentence and inserting “\$10,632,000”; and

10 (3) in section 6 by striking “\$80,000” from the
11 last sentence and inserting “\$2,000,000”.
