A BILL

For the relief of Jacqueline Salinas and her children Gabriela
Salinas, Alejandro Salinas, and Omar Salinas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Jacqueline Salinas and her children
7 Gabriela Salinas, Alejandro Salinas, and Omar Salinas,
8 shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-
9 ted to the United States for permanent residence as of

1 the date of enactment of this Act upon payment of the
2 required visa fees.

3 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF VISAS.**

4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Jac-
5 queline Salinas and her children Gabriela Salinas,
6 Alejandro Salinas, and Omar Salinas, as provided in this
7 Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer
8 to reduce by the appropriate number during the current
9 fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas available
10 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
11 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
12 1153(a)).
