To designate the United States courthouse located at 223 Broad Street in Albany, Georgia, as the “C.B. King United States Courthouse”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States courthouse located at 223 Broad
5 Street in Albany, Georgia, shall be known and designated
6 as the “C.B. King United States Courthouse”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the United

1 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
2 to be a reference to the “C.B. King United States Court-
3 house”.
